ABOUT RE REGISTRATION FEES

Many people have inquired about registration fees for the Religious Education program. This will hopefully clarify the funding of the program.

The RE program is funded directly from the SNUUC treasury. **The cost per child/youth for one year of Sunday Program is approximately \$500.** When making your Estimate of Giving for the year, please take this aspect of your financial obligation into consideration. This amount covers the cost of RE supplies, salaries, and more. Of course the \$500 per child only addresses the RE program, and so please consider all of the other areas that need to be funded when you make your **total** contribution to SNUUC (Minister's salary, building expenses, etc.)

***If you are not submitting a Pledge this year, the fee for Sunday Program tuition to SNUUC is \$500 per child/youth; which works out to \$50/month over the 10 month academic year. Financial hardship can be shared with the Minister or Director of Religious Education in confidence.*

There is a **Registration fee of \$60. per child/youth with a family cap of \$140.** for the program, to help offset the cost of heating, lighting and cleaning the RE wing. **This is payable to SNUUC by check, upon pre-registration. Please send your check along with the Registration form downloaded from our website.** Thank you, and please let us know if you are in need of financial assistance regarding your Registration fee.

DESCRIPTIONS OF RE VOLUNTEER JOBS

LEADING RE: Volunteers receive a written curriculum to follow for 8 weeks for the grade level of their choice when possible as Workshop Leaders; Assistants are there to honor Safety in Congregations UUA guidelines. Supplies are provided and there are orientations, training opportunities and ongoing support.

YOUTH GROUP ASSISTANTS: Volunteers assist the Youth Coordinator and the youth in their many and varied activities both on and off site on Sundays and other days as they are able.

SUBSTITUTE TEACHING: Volunteers are called in advance when needed. Materials and curriculum are provided.

SPECIAL EVENTS: Volunteers assist with events as needed and invited by members of the RE Committee.

SUNDAY SNACK PARENT: Volunteers prepare snack for all grade levels on Sunday mornings for 8-week semesters. Training & food is provided.

HOLIDAYS: Volunteers are invited to assist with decorating, food preparation, serving, and relevant preparations and clean up.
